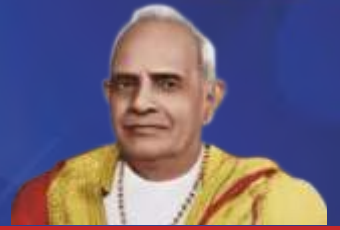

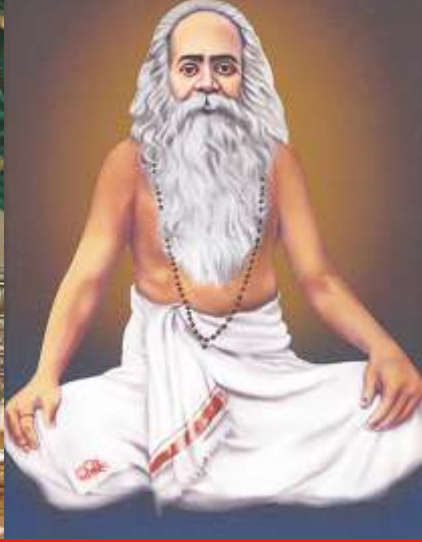

Parama Bhattaraka Vidyadhiraja Sree Chattampi Swamikal

A Great Social and Spiritual Reformer

*A Fond & Respectful Homage to the Swamiji on his 174th Jayanthi on
2nd September 2026*

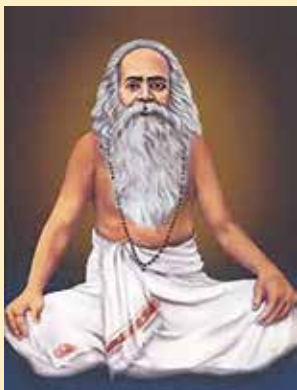
Parama Bhattaraka Vidyadhiraja Sree Chattampi Swamikal was born as Ayyappan Pillai, popularly known as Kunjan Pillai, on 25 August 1853 at Kannammoola in the southern part of Kerala. His father was Sri Vasudevan Namboothiri of Thamarassery Illam, originally from Mavelikkara, and his mother was Smt. Nangamma, a member of the Veniyath family of Malayinkeezh. Kunjan Pillai's childhood was marked by poverty and hardship. As his parents could not afford to provide him with formal education, his strong thirst for knowledge led him to learn letters and words from children in his neighbourhood who attended school. He learned Sanskrit by listening to lessons conducted at a nearby Brahmin household. Recognising the young boy's extraordinary desire to learn, an uncle took him to the traditional school of Sri. Pettayil Raman Pillai Asan, a renowned scholar and writer, who taught him without charging any fee. It was there that he earned the name "Chattampi", as he was given the responsibility of monitoring the class.

Because of his family's poverty, the responsibility of supporting them fell upon young Kunjan Pillai. He undertook many kinds of manual work to earn a living. For several days, he worked as a labourer carrying building materials for the construction of the Government Secretariat in Thiruvananthapuram. He also worked as a document writer and later as an advocate's clerk. He stood first in a test conducted by Sir T. Madhava Rao, the then Diwan of Travancore, for clerical posts in the Government Secretariat. However, he left the job after a short period because it restricted his freedom and prevented him from pursuing his spiritual exploration and quest for knowledge.

Chattampi Swamikal became a great scholar, philosopher, spiritual leader and social reformer. He strongly opposed the rigid and orthodox interpretation of Hindu scriptures and challenged the meaningless caste discrimination that prevailed in society. At a time when Kerala society was deeply divided by caste, rituals and social hierarchies, Swamikal worked courageously for equality, justice and human dignity. He met the renowned scholar Sri. Subba Jatapadikal of Kalladaikurichi in Tamil Nadu, who was well versed in Tarka, Vyakarana, Mimamsa and Vedanta. Recognising Kunjan Pillai's exceptional talent and eagerness to learn, Subba Jatapadikal accepted him as a disciple. Chattampi Swamikal spent many years studying under him and acquired deep knowledge of Tamil and Sanskrit scriptures and various branches of philosophy. He also learned Siddha medicine, music and martial arts. Swamikal dedicated his entire life to teaching and spreading spiritual knowledge. He promoted Advaita Vedanta, emphasising that the entire universe is a manifestation of one supreme reality. He also taught the importance of religious harmony, believing that different religions are simply different paths leading towards the same Divine Truth. Through his landmark work, Vedadikara Nirupanam, he challenged the monopoly of certain sections of society over sacred knowledge. He argued that spiritual knowledge and the study of the Vedas should be available to everyone, regardless of caste or gender.

He worked tirelessly to remove caste barriers, social discrimination and restrictions that denied people their dignity. He was a strong advocate of non-violence and vegetarianism. He also worked for the emancipation of women and encouraged women's education and their active participation in social advancement. His message was one of equality, freedom, knowledge, compassion and universal brotherhood. Towards the end of his life,

Chattampi Swamikal settled at Panmana in Kollam district. He attained Mahasamadhi on 5 May 1924, at the age of 70. During his final illness, he is remembered for refusing medicine. He was laid to rest at Panmana according to the traditional customs followed for Hindu saints.

As per English calendar, we commemorate the 173rd birth anniversary of this great spiritual leader and social reformer on 25 August 2026. However the Jayanthi is also celebrated on 'Bharani' star in the month of Chingam as per Malayalam calendar. The teachings of Sree Chattampi Swamikal are highly relevant even today. In a world still affected by discrimination, intolerance, violence and social divisions,

his message of human equality, religious harmony, non-violence, education and compassion continues to guide us. Therefore, let us not merely remember him on his birth anniversary. Let us make a sincere effort to understand his teachings, assimilate his values and practise them in our day-to-day lives.

Let me conclude with profound respect by bowing my head at the holy feet of Sree Chattampi Swamikal and offering my humble floral tribute to the great soul.

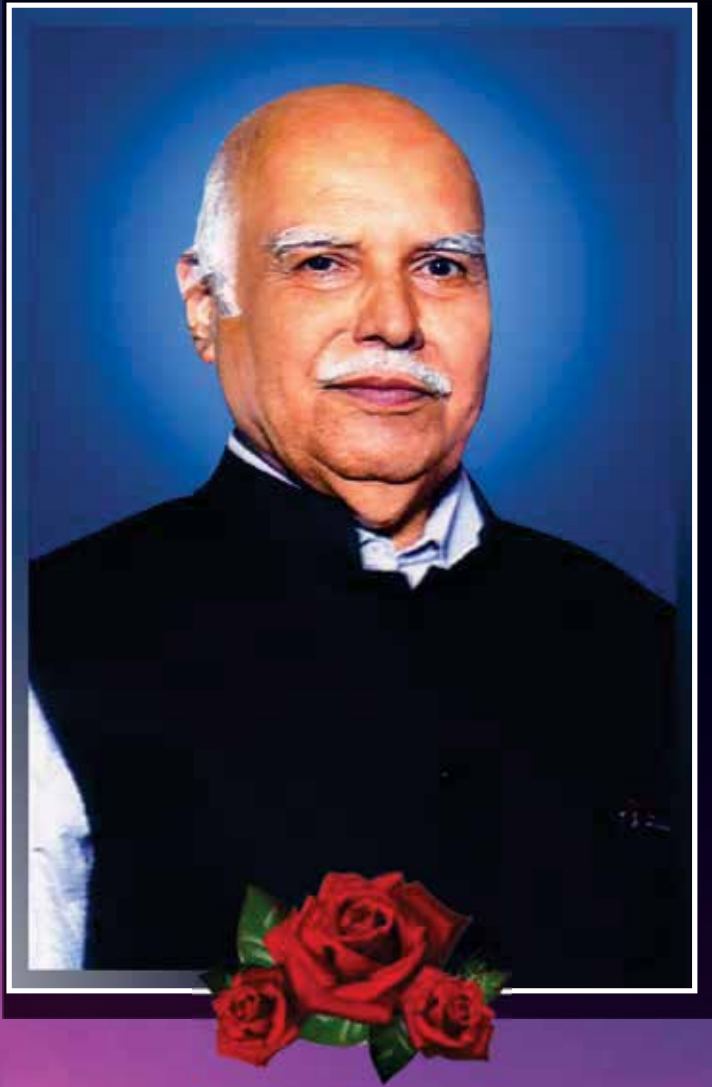
